



## FIBERGLASS BOOT INFORMATION SHEET

### Instructions On How To Decorate Your Boot

In order for your sculpture to remain intact and durable, it is important to properly prepare your sculpture for paint and protect it after paint is applied.

#### Prep For Paint

Lightly sand surface with 80 to 120 grit sandpaper. Do not over sand. If primer is flaking, wipe with denatured alcohol or a painters tack cloth. Re-priming is not necessary unless your paint of choice recommends it. In that case, follow paint manufactures instructions.

#### Painting

We highly recommend acrylic paints: Most brands will work fine. If you have specific questions please contact Icon Poly. We recommend staying away from oil paints if you do not have a lot of experience with them. If you intend to change the structure or add structure please contact Icon Poly for guidance.

#### Finishing

After your paint is done, you want to apply an automotive grade polyurethane base clear coat. These coating are available in easy to use spray cans at automotive supply stores or Auto Body paint facilities. If you have trouble finding this type of product, it is available through Icon Poly. Apply in several thin coats letting the prior coat tack up for several minutes before recoating. Three or four coats is sufficient, but you can apply more for a thicker clear coat effect.
